Our Homeless Kitchen Staff Transition



Our former cook, Deci Nieto, who cooked breakfast for our homeless the past 2 years recently retired, so there became an immediate need for a replacement! At the time, we didn't know what we were going to do since the position required someone to live at the bunkhouse (behind the House of Prayer where we feed the homeless). But as we all know, the Lord always provides! Eric Grant had been coming to the shelter for about a month and not only needed a place to stay, but he also knew how to cook! So Eric is now our new Kitchen Manager & Praise God! he is now no longer homeless!

Eric's Story



I had been living with my mom my entire 27 years of life, & never realized how much I had depended on her for everything. After my mom passed away in 2016, I was no longer able to support myself with no steady income or skills, so eventually I was evicted from our home & became homeless. Living on the streets left me with a lot of fear & uncertainty, not knowing from day to day where my next meal would be or where I was going to sleep at night. I was fortunate enough to be referred to the House of Prayer by another homeless person & when I arrived there, I was welcomed with open arms & provided with food, a sleeping bag, a place to shower & do my laundry. I kept coming back there every day because it was the one place I felt safe. Rev. Kris King also took time to minister to me about God which gave me the opportunity to reopen my relationship with him. I also began realizing that it was not luck or fate that brought me here, but all part of God's plan. He not only provided me with the help I desperately needed at the time, but the Lord continued to guide my path even further when the Cook position came open at the House of Prayer & since I already knew how to cook, I was given the opportunity to fill this role. So with just a bit of on the job training, I have now taken on the Kitchen Manager position, making breakfast for the homeless every morning Mon-Fri. It has been very rewarding & humbling spending this time with the homeless. Serves as a reminder to me daily how grateful I am & to not take anything for granted because I'm living proof that you can lose everything in the blink of an eye. I don't think I will ever be able to thank the House of Prayer staff enough for their generosity & for believing in me. But I'm mostly thankful to God for rescuing me out of the darkness I was living in & bringing peace & contentment back to my life again. I look forward to this new path & am excited to see what God has in store for me in the future.
